ULURU SUNRISE & FIELD OF LIGHT

FOL

Internationally acclaimed artist Bruce Munro is noted for his immersive site-specific installations that employ light to evoke emotional response, often in an outdoor context and on a monumental scale. His Field of Light, inspired by a trip to Uluru over 27 years ago, is installed in a remote desert area within sight of majestic Uluru. It is his largest installation to date, with Munro and his team installing more than 50,000 slender stems crowned with radiant frosted glass spheres. It is truly a magical sight to behold.

- Depart the resort in total darkness for the short drive to Bruce Munro's renowned Field of Light installation
- Take it all in from a private dune-top as your host provides details of the artist and his incredible undertaking
- Wander through the paths surrounding the 50,000 hand-crafted glass spheres of light, in colours of ochre, deep violet, blue and gentle white
- Why not find a quiet corner, covered under a blanket of stars, to immerse yourself in the silence?
- Return to the dune-top, where you'll be served a warming tea, coffee or hot chocolate. Watch as the dawn creeps across the desert plain and lights up Uluru – don't forget to look out for Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) behind you!
- Return to the resort in time for breakfast, your flight transfer or further activities
- A low level of fitness is required for this tour. We recommend you wear warm layers in cooler months

- Visit the tallest waterfall in Central Australia at Kantju Gorge
- Hear the Tjukurpa story of the cheeky Blue-tongue Lizard
- View ancient rock art and hear the story of Kuniya and Liru at the Mutitjulu Waterhole
- Return to Kuniya Piti and receive a souvenir certificate celebrating completion of the Uluru Base Walk!

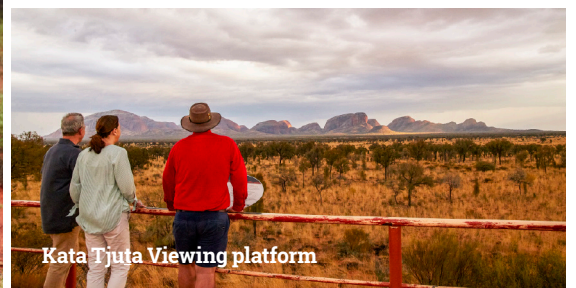

Kata Tjuta Viewing platform

Enjoy the intimacy of a small group to view sunrise at Kata Tjuta and a 5.4 kms walk with your Guide to Valley of the Winds. Hear fascinating stories of the geology, history and culture of Kata Tjuta. The walk to Valley of the Winds takes you down into a timeless haven within the domes through trickling creek beds.

- Departing the resort you'll be one of the first to enter Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park today
- Travel to the Kata Tjuta Dune Viewing platform and enjoy a warming tea, coffee or hot chocolate with your light breakfast
- Watch the dawn creep across the desert plain and light up the domes of Kata Tjuta
- Join your Driver Guide and Guide for the walk to the first lookout, Karu – your Guide will point out interesting rare plants along the way
- If you're feeling adventurous, take the challenging walk with your Guide to the second lookout, Karingana, and enjoy spectacular views into the heart of this sacred men's area

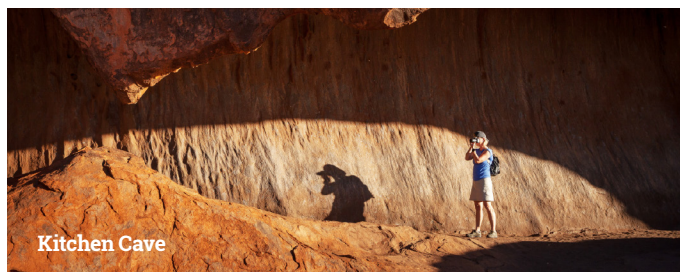

Experience the two major landmarks in Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. View an amazing sunrise at Uluru and then on the 45 kms drive to Kata Tjuta, your Driver Guide will provide a historical overview of the National Park.

- Enjoy a warming tea, coffee or hot chocolate as the dawn creeps across the desert plain and lights up Uluru
- Return to the coach for the scenic drive to the 36 domes of conglomerate rock that forms Kata Tjuta

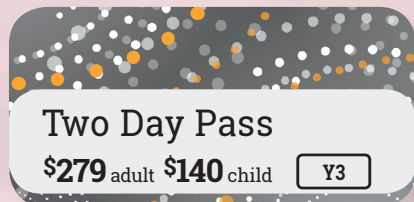

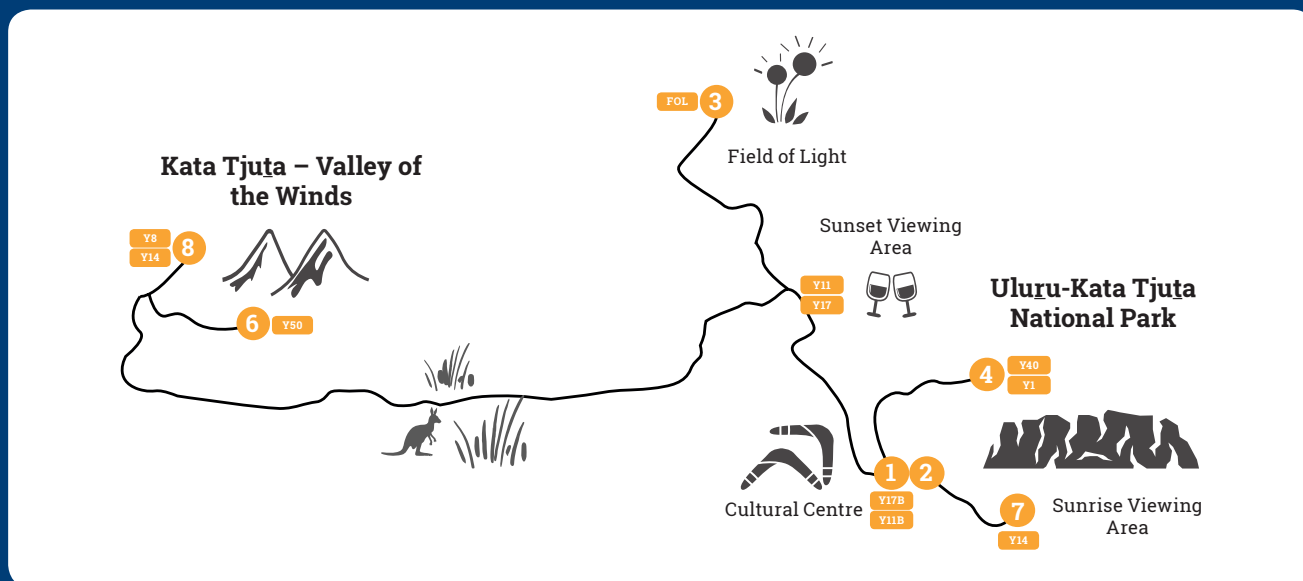
