# ANTARCTICA IS A FROZEN CONTINENT SURROUNDED BY OCEANS

## 17 TERRESTRIAL fauna species



**BIRDS:** wandering albatross, snow petrel, Antarctic skua, blue eyed shag, giant petrel, cape petrel, snowy sheathbill, Antarctica tern.  
**PENGUINS:** king penguins (South Georgia voyages only), adelin penguins, chinstrap penguins, Gentoo penguin.

## 235 MARINE fauna species



Seven pinniped species inhabit Antarctica. The largest, the elephant seal and the Antarctic fur seal live north of the sea ice. The other four species can live on the sea ice. Crabeater seals and Weddell seals, Leopard seals and Ross seals. There are 10 cetacean species; six baleen whales, and four toothed whales and Orcas.

## 950 FLORA species



Mosses and liverworts (plants with dormant life cycles) of the lichen, bryophyte, algae and fungi variety grown in Antarctica. Most growth lasts just a few weeks during the height of summer. There are 200 species of lichens and 50 species of moss in Antarctica, while algae are in abundance with 700 species of mostly phytoplankton.



### ICE SHEETS

## 98%

OF ANTARCTICA'S SURFACE

About 98% thick continental ice sheet and 2% barren rock. The ice surface dramatically grows in size from about 3 million square kilometers at the end of summer to about 19 million square kilometers by winter.



## ICE THICKNESS 2.16 km

The average thickness of the Antarctic ice sheet is 2.16 km; the maximum known thickness of the ice sheet is 4776 m (Terre Adélie). Without the ice, Antarctica may be the lowest lying continent; the greatest known depression of bedrock is the Byrd Subglacial Basin, at 2538 m below sea level.



## 1773 FIRST EXPLORED

In 1773 James Cook and his crew crossed the Antarctic Circle for the first time. They discovered South Georgia in 1775, but although Cook surmised a frozen continent further south they did not catch sight of Antarctica itself.

There are numerous research stations set up across the continent

## 126 BIRD species



Including 40 types of seabirds – 5 which breed nowhere else in the world. Eight species of penguin (Snare's Crested, Yellow Eyed, Fjordland Crested, Royal, Little, King, Gentoo & Rockhopper) and 11 species of Albatross.

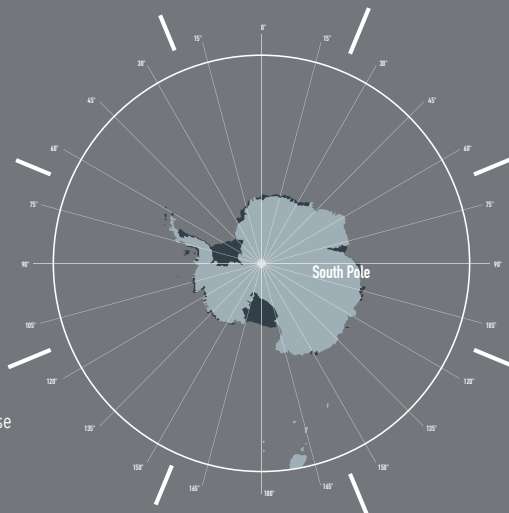
### AVERAGE TEMPERATURE

Only 660 hours of sunshine per year. Average rainfall is 1360mm per year. Winds of over 64km per hour occur on Campbell Island on over 280 days per year.

## 95% OF SEA LIONS breed here



More than 95% of the world's population of New Zealand Sea Lions breed here. Home to over 200,000 NZ Fur Seals, 75,000 Southern Elephant Seals, 10,000 NZ Sea Lions. Leopard Seals and various whale species frequent the islands also.



## 1810

### MACQUARIE ISLANDS accidentally discovered

Macquarie Islands discovered accidentally in 1810 by Frederick Hasselborough, who was searching for new sealing grounds.

## 250 PLANT species



250 vascular land plant species, 35 of these are endemic. Kelps, marine algae and seagrasses are also abundant.

## 261 TERRESTRIAL fauna species



The Arctic is seasonally populated by roughly 200 species of birds, corresponding to about 2% of global avian species diversity. Every summer thousands of seabirds flock to breed in numerous colonies. 61 terrestrial mammal species only a few hardy species such as the Arctic Fox, Svalbard Reindeer and Polar Bears stay year round facing the cold and dark months of the winter.

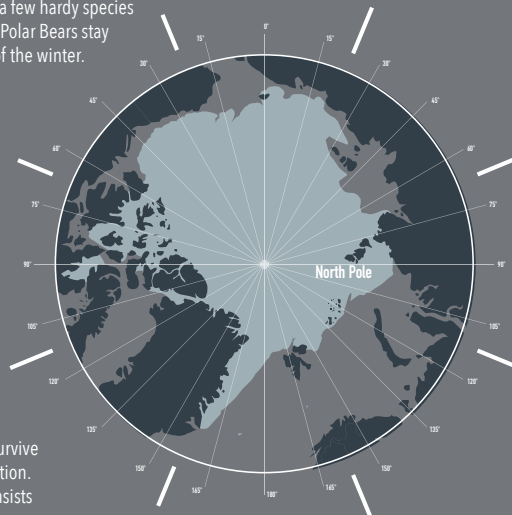


There are 12 species of marine mammals that regularly inhabit the Arctic: 4 species of whales (Bowhead, Grey, narwhal and Beluga), the polar bear, the walrus, and 6 species of ice-associated seals (Bearded, ribbon, Ringed, Spotted, Harp and Hooded). Several additional species (e.g. Sperm whales, Blue whales, Fin Whales, Humpback Whales, Killer Whales, Harbor Porpoise) are spotted occasionally.

## 1,700 PLANT species



Plants have developed surprising strategies to survive in this harsh environment, like asexual reproduction. The vegetation of tundra is low growing, and consists mainly of sedges, grasses, dwarf shrubs, wildflowers, mosses, and lichens.

Ice sheets hold about 77% of the World's freshwater, of this only 10% in the Greenland Icecap, so 7.7% of the world's freshwater is in Greenland. The Greenland Ice sheet covers staggering 1,71 million sq km.



## ICE THICKNESS 2/3 Km

About 98% thick continental ice sheet and 2% barren rock. Much of Ice Sheet is over 2km thick and it is 3km at its thickest point. If the whole 2.85 million cubic kilometres of ice were to melt it would raise global sea levels by 7.2m or 23.6ft.



## 1906 FIRST EXPLORED

The Northwest Passage was navigated by Roald Amundsen, a famous Norwegian polar explorer who also led the first successful expedition to the South Pole.



## 4 MILLION POPULATION

Indigenous populations now range from about 80% in Greenland, 50% in Canada, 20% in Alaska, 15% in Arctic Norway and 4% in Arctic Russia.
